


ROLEX 24 at Daytona Fast Facts

- The 2014 Rolex 24 at Daytona marks the first race of the newly united Tudor Sports Car Series, a combination of the American LeMans Series and the Rolex Sports Car Series, giving North America a single sports car series for the first time in well over a decade.
- The new series has 4 classes, 2 for prototypes and 2 for street-based GT cars.
- Prototype - the fastest class is a combination of the LMP2 class from last years American lemans series and the Daytona prototypes from the Rolex sports car series. IMSA has done a lot of testing in the off season to balance the performance between the 2 classes, but nobody knows which, if any, car has an advantage going into the new season.
- Prototype Challenge - this is a spec-series with chassis built by the French company ORECA, with Chevrolet motor in the back. The PC class is meant to be an inexpensive, but exotic, entry into endurance racing.
- GTLM - the fastest of the two GT classes, these street based cars are allowed significant modification to body's, chassis and engines with exotic materials allowed.
- GTD - this class, run with many of the same cars found in the GTLM class, is much closer to street based cars, with more of a limitation on modifications and exotic materials.
- The P2 cars from the prototype class and the GTLM cars are both run to rules that will allow them to compete in the 24 hours of LeMans if the teams choose to. The Daytona prototypes and GTD cars are not eligible for LeMans.
- There will be 15 Canadians competing in this year's race – 7 from Ontario, 5 from Quebec and 3 from British Columbia.
- Ron Fellows is the only Canadian to win the race overall, when he won it against all odds as a member of the Corvette team in the GT class against the faster Daytona Prototypes.


